

## **CBRPA REQUIREMENTS for ALTERNATE ELIGIBILITY**

The CBRPA Board of Directors acknowledges that registered technologists who attended and successfully completed educational programs in the late 1970s and early 1980s entitled *Radiology Assistant Programs* are currently practicing at the level of the Radiology Practitioner Assistants (RPA). To provide a mechanism that would enable these individuals to become recognized and certified by the CBRPA, the listed requirements must be met.

### **CBRPA Alternate Eligibility Requirements**

**To ensure the integrity of the CBRPA certification process and the registration of qualified individuals by the CBRPA, the listed requirements must be met by individuals seeking recognition and certification by the CBRPA and the use of the professional credential of *RPA* following their name.**

- Possess active certification and registration with the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT).**
- Provide verification of attendance and successful completion of a program of study at the level of the Radiology Practitioner Assistant (RPA), such as, Radiology Assistant programs conducted by the University of Kentucky or Duke University or successfully challenge the course examinations from a CB RPA recognized program.**
- Provide verification from a radiologist that the current level of practice by the candidate includes performing the clinical competencies listed as mandatory in the Competency Requirements for the CBRPA certification examination.**
- Successfully pass the CBRPA certification examination.**
