

CERTIFICATION BOARD FOR RADIOLOGY PRACTITIONER ASSISTANTS

Agreement of Applicants for Renewal of Registration

“I hereby apply to the Certification Board for Radiology Practitioner Assistants for renewal of registration of a certificate in the discipline of Radiology Practitioner Assistant and agree to abide by Governing Documents of the Certification Board for Radiology Practitioner Assistants (CBRPA). The Governing Documents of the CBRPA include the Code of Ethics, the Scope of Practice, the Standards of Practice and governing policies.”

“By signing this document and filing it with the CBRPA, I understand and agree that:

1. I am and at all times since the date of my initial application for examination have been in compliance with the Governing Documents of the Certification Board for Radiology Practitioner Assistants;
2. the CBRPA may confirm the information contained in this application and may also request information relating to my employment and relevant personal history;
3. I am legally bound by and shall abide by all the terms and conditions required by the CBRPA to maintain my CBRPA certificate;
4. upon issuance to me of a renewal of my CBRPA certificate, I shall remain bound by the CBRPA Governing Documents.”

“I hereby certify that the information given in this application is true, correct and complete, and that I have read and accept the terms and conditions set forth by the CBRPA Governing Documents. I understand and agree that:

1. any misrepresentation in this application or in any other CBRPA document or other information I submit will constitute grounds for the CBRPA to revoke or suspend my certificate, to deny or reject my application for renewal of registration of my certificate;
2. the CBRPA’s decision on any such matter is final and binding on me.
3. I will maintain an active compliance of my certification with ARRT as a registered technologist;
4. I will maintain an active ACLS certification. “

“I understand that if registration is renewed by CBRPA, the CBRPA may issue to me one or more forms of printed certificate or card to evidence such registration. I understand and agree that each such form of printed certificate or card remains the property of CBRPA and shall be returned to the CBRPA upon request;

1. I may indicate my registration with CBRPA by displaying any such certificate or card in my place of practice, and by factual statement on stationery, in advertisements, and in resumes, biographical sketches and the like, using the name of Certification Board for Radiology Practitioner Assistants or a recognizable abbreviation of the name; and
2. the name of the CBRPA and logo of the CBRPA shall not be used by me on any other certificate or material displayed, prepared, or distributed by or for me, or any other sign or display used by or for me, without the CBRPA’s prior written permission.”
3. each such form of printed certificate or identification card remains the property of CBRPA and shall be returned to CBRPA upon request;
4. I will uphold the tenets of CBRPA and promote the professional status of the RPA..”

“I hereby waive and release, and shall indemnify and hold harmless, the CBRPA and persons in their capacities as the CBRPA’s directors, officers, employees and agents from, against and with respect to any and all claims, losses, costs, expenses, damages, and judgments (including reasonable attorney’s fees) that arise or are alleged to have risen, from, out of, with respect to, or in connection with any action which they, or any of them, take or fail to take as a result of or in connection with this application, and, if applicable, the failure of the CBRPA to renew the registration of a certificate previously issued to me. I understand and agree that in the event of my breach of or default in any provision of this application and agreement in any respect whatsoever, the CBRPA shall have the absolute right, in its absolute discretion, to revoke or suspend any certificate issued to me, refuse renewal of the registration of my certificate, censure me, and/or cancel my registration with the CBRPA and to provide information regarding such circumstances to all legitimately interested persons without restriction.”
