

CBRPA Policy for Reinstatement of Certification

Rationale: The CBRPA recognizes that certain socio-economic factors may be prohibitive in allowing CBRPA certificants to maintain an annual certification. The CBRPA feels it is appropriate to provide a pathway to reinstate a prior certificate while fulfilling its obligation to the public to ensure the ongoing competence level of its certificate holders.

Eligibility: Those seeking reinstatement of an expired CBRPA certification must meet the following criteria;

- The certificate in question can be in arrears no longer than 3 years.

- Petitioner must have active ARRT registration with full CE compliance.

- Must possess an Active ACLS certification.

- A certificate holder more than 5 years in arrears must complete the certification examination.

Procedure: ALL elements of the reinstatement procedure for 5 years or less must be completed.

- Petitioner will provide a brief narrative describing the reason for the lapse in certification renewal, as well as a formal request for reinstatement.

- A fee of \$450 penalty is paid to CBRPA.

- Successful completion of annual recertification seminar including exam (this requires travel to CBRPA annual meeting at petitioner's expense)
